

MLS Homestay Accommodation 2020

MLS takes great care in selecting homestay accommodation on behalf of its students. All homestays are different and this reflects the wonderful mix of society in the UK. Houses and rooms come in different shapes and sizes and hosts themselves may be families, singles, couples, young or elderly. Homestays may be close to the College or may require a bus journey.

We ensure minimum standards and all students booking homestay accommodation should expect the following:

- * Half board (ie dinner and breakfast Monday to Friday / dinner, lunch and breakfast at weekends).
- * Single room, clean and comfortable, with access to a study desk in either the bedroom or in the homestay.
- * Use of a bathroom on a reasonable use basis.
- * A reasonable area for storage, such as a wardrobe.
- * Bed linen and towels, washed by the homestay on a weekly basis.
- * To be the only student of your native language resident in the home.

Examples of where additional charges may accrue, although not limited to such examples are: more than one clothes wash per week; specialist dietary requirements.
